1. Church Presentations:

2. Maintain basic records of visits, audiences reached, and feedback received.

- **Young Christian lawyers** or professionals with backgrounds in **marketing, business development, public speaking, or legal awareness**.
- Must be a **practicing Christian** with a good grasp of Christian values and church culture.
- Prior experience in public speaking, training, legal literacy programs, or NGO work is an advantage.

Skills & Qualities Required:

- Strong communication and presentation skills
- Confident, warm, and respectful presence before congregations
- Ability to handle Q&A and legal queries with composure
- Cultural sensitivity and spiritual maturity
- Openness to attend other churches on certain Sundays
